GENERAL CLUB RULES:

Although we are a club dedicated to fun flying, there are some rules relating to safety and common-sense:

1. Never fly near power lines. If a kite becomes entangled in power lines, leave it there and advise the power company as soon as possible.
2. Never fly in or with thunderstorms approaching or in the rain. Wet kite line conducts electricity.
3. Always observe air safety regulations - including a 90 metre height limit in any controlled air space.
4. Use your kite in an open area - away from people, buildings, trees, cars, power lines and animals.
5. Never "BUZZ" people with your kite. It is unsafe as you could hurt someone.
6. Always respect other flyers, their kites and their flying space. If they were there first, ask before you fly.
7. Kevlar fly line is banned from club days and should be avoided at other times. It is abrasive and will cut other lines, including Spectra.
8. Always clean up any rubbish, including broken strings and spars before you leave.
9. **KITE BUGGIERS:** Always know your limitations, DO NOT exceed your skill level. On public beaches be aware of spectators and the general public—always bring your kite above you, passing downwind of the public ... And SLOW DOWN—you should be at walking pace when passing. Permits required on some beaches.
10. **KITE SURFING:** Always be aware of other users in the water. Always launch and land downwind from the general public and spectators. If spectators are close, ask them to move behind you for safety reasons.

Above all else, we want you to have fun when you fly. Follow the above rules and you and those around you will have a fun safe time. Fail to do so and your membership may be in JEOPARDY.

AKFA INSURANCE:

1. AKFA has an extensive Public and Property Liability Cover in Australia
2. This insurance is Public and Property Liability Only—it will not cover you if you injure yourself or your gear—it is designed to cover the general public.
3. It carries a \$1000 excess.
4. If an accident does occur please take appropriate action with the injured party, gather as much information (contact detail, etc) as possible from bystanders, witnesses to the accident, notify a member of the AKFA Committee as soon as possible.

PLEASE NOTE: Even though we have extensive cover, the club does not approve of members acting in irresponsible and reckless forms of kiting activities that may harm themselves or the general public.

Always abide by the club safety rules.

IF YOU HAVE ONLY JOINED WITH A BASIC MEMBERSHIP AND PROGRESS INTO THE TRACTION AND POWER SIDE OF KITING WE REQUEST YOU UPGRADE YOUR MEMBERSHIP—THIS WILL ENSURE YOU HAVE APPROPRIATE COVER.
